The possible areas of research include but not restricted to: Floristics of unexplored/underexplored areas, Revisionary/Monographic studies on families/genera, Molecular systematics, Taxonomy of endemic groups/plants and Phylogenetic studies. Two members of PAC would monitor the proposals and facilitate their evaluation for funding by SERB-DST.
